1. Resource photos of rural landscapes or buildings (photos will be available if needed)
2. Paper towels/facial tissue
3. Small sponges
4. Watercolor brushes; round, flat and wash brushes
5. Water container and palate
6. Drawing pencils #2
7. Masking tape

8. Watercolor sketch pad and paper. We will use watercolor board also as the paper for the individual painting. All paper should be cold press of at least 140 lb. If you wish to use watercolor paper you will need a hard board to stretch and attach the paper on.

Watercolor board can be obtained from most online art supply sites. I will have some available for those who can not obtain it at cost.
